Scripture

Catechism

"Nobody may be forced to act against his convictions, nor is anyone to be restrained from acting in accordance with his conscience in religious matters in private or in public, alone or in association with others, within due limits." 34 This right is based on the very nature of the human person, whose dignity enables him freely to assent to the divine truth which transcends the temporal order." Catechism of the Catholic Church #2106

The reverse is also true; states that attempt to stifle, control or eradicate the most intimate relationship between the creature and the Creator will not hesitate to violate other laws that pertain to human freedom.
